The program is designed to provide financial assistance to qualified veterans or their surviving spouses, who do not have the financial resources to pay for their day to day care. At Yorkshire Village, we will help you apply and qualify for the benefits that you deserve.

The Veterans affairs Aid and Attendance Benefits can pay qualified individuals up to:

- Single veteran \$1,794 a month
- Veteran with spouse \$2,127 a month
- Surviving spouse \$1,153 a month



Veterans or the veterans surviving spouse may be eligible for Aid & Attendance if the some of the following are met:

- Must be a wartime veteran with limited or no income, and at least 65 yrs. Old. You can have income & assets and still financially qualify. Call for details.
- Did not have a dishonorable discharge, and served during specific wartimes. (WW1, WW2, Korean Conflict, Vietnam War, Gulf War)
- The aid is needed for personal functions required in everyday living, bathing, feeding, dressing, toileting, adjusting prosthetic devices, etc.
- OR The disabilities require the claimant to be bedridden, or in a SNF, or blind from physical or mental incapacity
