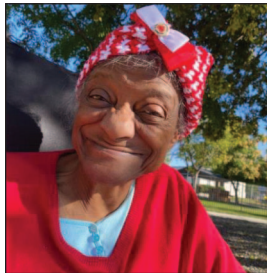
Valentine's Day Candlelit Lunch

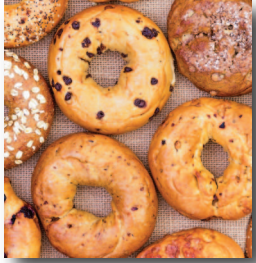

**NORMAN
ROCKWELL**
(1894 TO 1978)

A celebrated American painter and illustrator, Norman Rockwell's art reflected the commonplace culture of America. He is most famous for his illustrations of everyday life that graced the cover of *The Saturday Evening Post* magazine for almost five decades. Rockwell's work has the distinct ability to evoke a strong emotional response, likely due to the viewer's memories of formative events from their own lives resulting in a nostalgia for a time long past. From adorable young children to heroic soldiers in battle to tongue-in-cheek commentaries on contemporary American culture at the time, Rockwell covered so much in the visual space of a single picture.

Cornhole

Cornhole is a lawn game that's quite popular in North America. In the game, players take turns throwing fabric bean bags at a raised, angled downwards 48" long board with a circular hole positioned at the top end. The objective of the game is to score points when you land a bag on the board (usually worth one point) or throw the bag through the hole (usually worth three points).

The game was initially made to emulate indoors the game of Quoits, which is a game similar to horse shoes, whereby you throw steel discs at a metal pipe and is played outside.

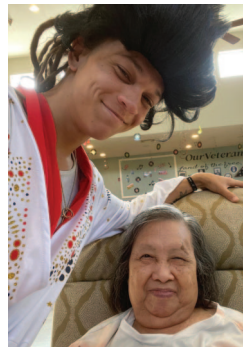
Today, there is a "governing body for the sport of cornhole" called the American Cornhole Organization (ACO) that was established in 2005, an American Cornhole Association (ACA) whose sole mission is to help cornhole players enjoy the game of cornhole, and finally, an American Cornhole League (ACL) that was founded in 2015 by Stacey Moore to help promote and develop the sport on every level.

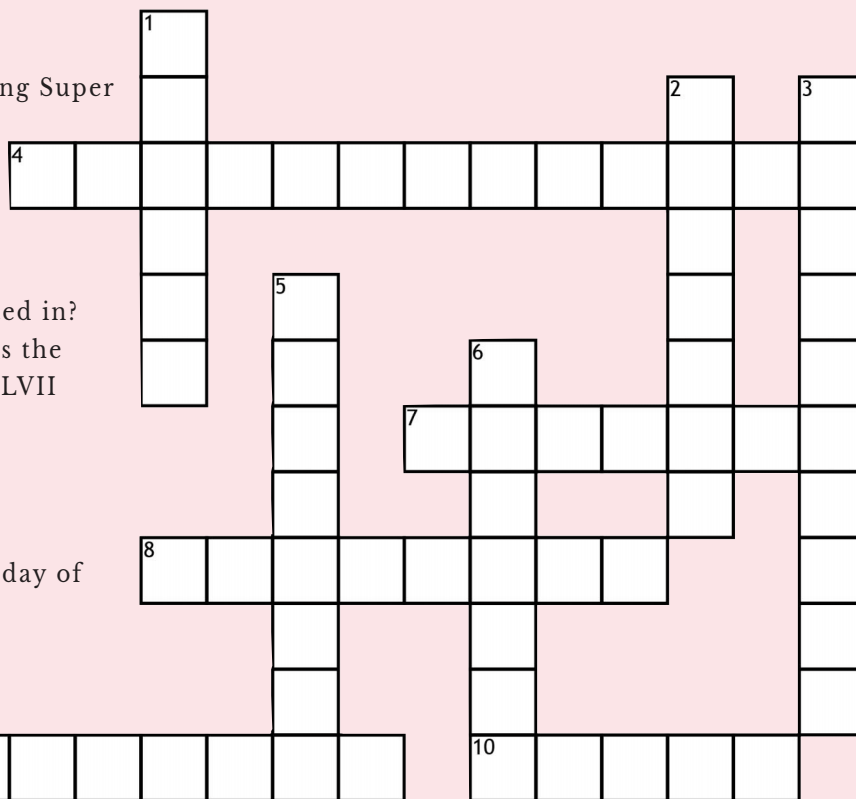
